**Subject :** Conventional Berths

Due to intensive demand which our terminal has recently faced, the fact that increased conventional cargo tonnages per vessel, below measures will be taken as of 03.06.2022 until further notice.

1-) Berth 12 will be re-opened to serve for dry bulk and general cargo vessels as well as container vessel according to operational conditions.

2-) In berths 17 and 19, berthing priority will be given to vessels which contain dry bulk cargo.

3-) In berths 20 and 21, berthing priority will be given to vessels which contain general cargo (big bag, sling bag, cotton bale, pallet, etc).

4-) In berths 2/3/13/16 and 15, dry bulk and general cargo operations are going to be conducted according to operational conditions.

5-) Vessels carrying TMO's (Toprak Mahsulleri Ofisi) dry bulk cargoes and vessels carrying liquid bulk cargoes will be served in 14. and 15. berths as usual.

MIP will continue to reserve its rights to determine the berthing plan considering berth specifications, the condition and specifications of equipment on the berth, and of others which will serve the vessel, the vessels length and draft, weather conditions and all other operational conditions.
